Regular Days: 4:00 AM to 10:00 PM, (inner sanctum); complex open 24 hours. Festival Days (Guru Nanak Jayanti, Baisakhi, Diwali, etc.) Same, with extended ceremonies. Closed: Never, but inner sanctum closes from 10:00 PM to 2:30 AM for cleaning. Darshan is free for devotees. During Baisakhi or Guru Nanak Jayanti, visit at 3:30 AM to avoid Kived Prakash: 4:00 AM. No booking needed; arrive at the lobby. Cell or asthanavani. Langar feeds 100,000+ daily, especially during Baisakhi. By Road: 2 km from Amritsar Bus Stand. By Train: Amritsar Junction (2 km). By Air: Sri Guru Ram Das Jee Airport (13 km). Dress Code: Cover head (sarees/veils provided), modest attire (no shorts/sleeveless), Best Trousers Outfit (10-25°C). Avoid Jun-Sep (heat). Amritsar Golden Temple Timings and Langar Timings:Golden Temple located in Amritsar is also known as Darbar Sahib or Sri Harmandir Sahib. Sri Harmandir Sahib is not only a central religious place of the Sikhs but also a symbol of human brotherhood and equality. Everybody, irrespective of caste, creed or race can seek spiritual solace and religious fulfillment without any hindrance. More than one lakh devotees visit every day. So, The World Book of Records has declared that Golden Temple is the most visited place in the World. No trip to Amritsar is complete without a visit to the Golden Temple. In the Golden Temple the "Darbar Hall" is washed with milk daily. Water and milk are mixed and used. While entering to the temple premises everyone has to cover their head, without covering their heads you cannot enter inside. Timings: 2:30 AM to 10:00 PM (all days of the week).The Kiwad (door/portals) opens at 2:30 am. The First Hukamnama is given at 5:00 a.m. The temple closes with the departure of Palki Sahib from Sri Harmandir Sahib Guru ka Langar (Langar Hall) is open to all people. Langar meal is served at ALL HOURS. Meals in the langar are vegetarian and are simple, nourishing and nutritious. The kitchen has a capacity of 5000 people. There are two kitchens in which the food is prepared. On normal days, all the dishes are handmade by the sewadars. Hygiene is of utmost importance, both before and after meals. Dirty plates are handed over to another set of volunteers. Each plate is washed 5 times before being used again. The kitchen receives a lot of donations too, either in cash or kind. They also say to take food according to their needs. Don't waste the food and you have to complete the food. Amritsar golden templeThe best time to visit is during Sikhism festivals like Vaisakhi (the second week of April).Other top festival days are the birthday of Guru Ram Das, the Martyrdom day of Guru Teg Bahadur and others. Visitors worldwide are welcome to come and experience its peaceful and spiritual environment during these hours. It's worth noting that the main area where the Guru Granth Sahib is kept follows a particular schedule. You can visit from the early morning during the Palki Sahib ceremony until late night when it's returned to rest. For the best experience, plan to visit the Golden Temple early in the morning or late in the evening. The temple opens at 4 AM, and you can catch the first prayers at sunrise, called Prakash. It's a calm way to start your day. You can also go around 10 PM to see the Sukhshan ceremony, when the temple is lit up beautifully against the night sky. These times aren't only quiet but also more relaxed, which is a relief during the hot months. So, when planning your trip, think about going at these times to feel the peace of this sacred place. To visit the Golden Temple in Amritsar, fly into Sri Guru Ram Dass Jee International Airport, which is about 11 kilometers away from the temple.
